MOTOR VEHICLE ACT

Regulation made by Order-in-Council No., approved 1969,
pursuant to Section 199 (1).

Regulation Amending B.C. Regulation 26/58

The Regulations published as B.C. Regulation 26/58, as amended from time to time, are further amended by cancelling "Schedule 10 - Highways" in Section 19.09, and by substituting therefor the following:-

Trans-Canada Highway No. 1

- (a) from Victoria to Nanaimo;
- (b) from Horseshoe Bay to Taylor Way in West Vancouver;
- (c) from its junction with Highway No. 401 at Bridal Falls to the west boundary of Yoho National Park, excluding sections through Mount Revelstoke and Glacier National Parks.

Southern Trans-Canada Highway No. 3

from its junction with Trans-Canada Highway No. 1 at Hope via Richter Pass, Kinnaird, Trail, Salmo and Creston to the Provincial Boundary at Crowsnest.

Southern Trans-Canada Highway No. 3A

- (a) from its junction with Highway No. 3 at Keremeos to its junction with Okanagan Highway No. 97 at Kaleden Junction;
- (b) from its junction with Highway No. 3 at Kinnaird via Nelson, Balfour and Kootenay Bay to its junction with Highway No. 3 at Creston.

Southern Trans-Canada Highway No. 3B

from its junction with Highway No. 3 at Nancy Greene Lake via Rossland to its junction with Highway No. 3 at Trail.

Okanagan Highway No. 97

from the International Boundary at Oroville to its junction with Trans-Canada Highway No. 1 at Monte Creek.

Okanagan Highway No. 97A

from its junction with Okanagan Highway No. 97 at Swan Lake to Trans-Canada Highway No. 1 at Sicamous.

Okanagan Highway No. 97B

from its junction with Okanagan Highway No. 97A at Tomkinson's Corner to the Trans-Canada Highway No. 1 at Larch Hill near Salmon Arm.

John Hart-Peace River Highway No. 97

from Prince George to Dawson Creek.

Patterson-Rossland Highway No. 22

from the International Boundary at Patterson to its junction with Highway No. 3B at Rossland.

Elko-Rooseville Highway No. 92

from its junction with Southern Trans-Canada Highway No. 3 at Elko to the International Boundary at Rooseville

Yahk-Kingsgate Highway No. 95

from the International Boundary at Kingsgate to its junction with Southern Trans-Canada Highway No. 3 at Yahk.

Kootenay Columbia Highway No. 95 and No. 93

- (a) from its junction with Southern Trans-Canada Highway No. 3 south of Fort Steele via Fort Steele and Wasa to Radium Hot Springs;
- (b) Highway No. 95 from Radium Hot Springs to its junction with Trans-Canada Highway No. 1 at Golden;
- (c) Highway No. 93 from Radium Hot Springs to the boundary of Kootenay National Park.

Cranbrook Junction-Wasa Highway No. 95A

from its junction with Southern Trans-Canada Highway No. 3 at Cranbrook via Kimberley to its junction with Kootenay Columbia Highway No. 95 and No. 93 at Wasa Junction.

Nelson-Nelway Highway No. 6

from the International Boundary at Nelway via Salmo to its junction with Southern Trans-Canada Highway No. 3A in Nelson.

Christina Lake-Laurier Highway No. 395

from the International Boundary at Laurier to its junction with Southern Trans-Canada Highway No. 3.
