Pursuant to the Public Service Superannuation Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

THREE YEARS SIX MONTHS OF THE PERIOD September 15, 1942 to April 1, 1946, during which Maurice Paul Dorland Trumpour, Agriculturist, Ministry of Agriculture, served as a member of Her Majesty's Forces be recognized as pensionable service under the provisions of the said Act.

AND FURTHER ORDERS THAT Maurice Paul Dorland Trumpour be required to make a contribution to the Public Service Superannuation Fund in the amount of \$6,031.39 to cover the aforementioned period pursuant to Section 2, item "pensionable service", clause (b) of the said Act.
