EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA -9. DEC. 1976

Pursuant to the Teachers' Pensions Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

WHEREAS Lester Ray Peterson, teacher, resigned from the teaching service and received a refund of his contributions to the Teachers' Pensions Fund in the amount of \$171.04;

AND WHEREAS Lester Ray Peterson has requested in writing that this account be reinstated;

AND WHEREAS Lester Ray Peterson is now a contributor to the Teachers' Pensions Fund having commenced contributions once again on September 1, 1951;

THE PERIOD September 1938 to June 30, 1943, be recognized as pensionable service under the provisions of the said Act.

AND FURTHER ORDERS THAT Lester Ray Peterson be required to make a contribution to the Teachers' Pensions Fund in the amount of \$982.37 to cover the aforementioned period, pursuant to Section 10, subsection (1a), clause (b) of the said Act.
