EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA 16. DEC. 1976

Pursuant to the Criminal Code ~~X444~~ and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

WHEREAS Anthony Edwin SEYMOUR was charged with possession of a weapon dangerous to the public peace and assault Peace Officer and by order of Judge M. A. Lundeen of the Provincial Court at Salmon Arm on June 4, 1976 was on account of insanity found unfit to stand his trial and was ordered to be kept in strict custody in the Forensic Psychiatric Institute until the pleasure of the Lieutenant-Governor is known and regarding whom satisfactory evidence has been submitted that he has recovered from his mental illness;

Anthony Edwin SEYMOUR be taken to a Court of competent jurisdiction for trial or other disposition according to law.
