EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA 16. DEC. 1976

Pursuant to the ESCHEATS Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

WHEREAS:

1. BETH HAMIDROSH BNAI JACOB, a charitable society, (hereinafter referred to as "the society") was struck off the Register of Companies on the 13th day of March, 1947 for failing to file Annual Reports and was restored to the Register on the 17th day of October, 1975;
2. The society is the registered owner in fee simple of the following described lands:-

City of Vancouver	
Lot	3
Block	498
District Lot	472
Group	1, NEW WESTMINSTER DISTRICT
Plan	1308

(hereinafter referred to as "the property");

3. By being struck off the Register, the property of the society escheated to Her Majesty the Queen in Right of the Province of British Columbia;
4. By affidavit evidence it has been established that the society has a moral or legal claim to the property and all property taxes have been paid;

All the right, title and interest of the Crown in Right of the Province of British Columbia acquired by the escheat of the property but not further or otherwise be granted and conveyed to the society without further formal instrument of transfer.
