WHEREAS the Provincial Department of Highways and Public Works requires the following described property for use as a gravel pit:

That part of District Lot 8649 shown outlined in red on District Plan 10-184 said to contain 5.73 acres more or less

AND WHEREAS the registered owner, Harry Soloveoff, has offered to sell the said land to Her Majesty the Queen for the sum of Four Thousand Five Hundred and Eighty-Four Dollars (\$4,584.00)

AND WHEREAS investigations have been made concerning the value of the land and it is considered that the said offer is a fair and reasonable one.

THE SAID LAND be acquired and taken possession of in the name of Her Majesty the Queen in right of the Province of British Columbia for the purchase price of Four Thousand Five Hundred and Eighty-Four Dollars (\$4,584.00)
