EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA 16. DEC. 1976

Pursuant to the HIGHWAYS Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

WHEREAS the following lands are no longer required for the use of the Department of Highways and Public Works:

Part of Lot 100 of Lot 1, Group 3, Plan 25172, District of Mission, N.W.D.; Lots 70, 71 and 72 of Lot 1, Group 3, Plan 841, N.W.D.; Parcel "C" Reference Plan 5112 of D.L. 1, Group 3, N.W.D., except portion on Reference Plan 9775; Lot 1 of Parcel "E" of D.L. 1, Group 3, Plan 8351, N.W.D.; Lot 3, of Parcel "B" of Lot 16 of Lot 1, Group 3, Plan 20699 N.W.D. shown as Parcels 1 and 2 and outlined green on Highway Plan 50216.

AND WHEREAS by notice dated June 17, 1976 and published in the Fraser Valley Record of July 7, 1976, the Minister of Highways and Public Works has declared surplus the above noted property.

AND WHEREAS the Minister of Highways and Public Works deems it desirable to transfer to Turner Building Products Limited the above noted property.

THE LAND COMPRISED in that part of road allowance hereinbefore mentioned be transferred to Turner Building Products Limited, without further or formal instrument of transfer, but upon compliance with the provisions of the "Land Registry Act", subject to the conditions of the "Highway Act" and all other powers thereunto enabish, subject to the reservations, limitations, provisos, and conditions expressed in the original grant thereof from the Crown, and to the registered charges, if any, and that the Minister of Highways and Public Works be authorized to execute and deliver such further assurances of the above described lands as may in the premises be required.
