EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA 16. DEC. 1976

Pursuant to the Highway Act, Section 11 (2) (a) ~~and~~ and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

WHEREAS by notice dated November 12th., 1976 and published in the British Columbia Gazette of November 18th., 1976, the Minister of Highways and Public Works discontinued and closed all those portions of road allowance known as Jones Street lying 30 feet easterly of the east boundary of Lots 9 to 12, inclusive, Block 3, and extending to the north bank of the north fork of the Kettle River; of road allowance known as Seymour Street lying 25 feet southerly of the south boundary of Lot 1, Block 11; and of road allowance known as Greenwood Street, lying between Blocks 11 and 12, all in District Lot 1261, Plan 53, S.D.Y.D., as shown outlined in green on a plan recorded in the Ministry of Highways and Public Works, Victoria, B.C., on File 2070-3 (being a copy of Highway District Plan 14-99).

AND WHEREAS the Minister of Highways and Public Works deems it desirable to transfer to THE GRANBY MINING COMPANY LIMITED, 1111 West Georgia Street, Vancouver, B.C., the registered owner of Lots 9, 10, 11 and 12, Block 3, Plan 53; Lots 6, 7 and 8, Block 10, Plan 53; Lots 1 to 8 inclusive, Block 11, Plan 53; Lots 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5, Block 12, Plan 53, all in District Lot 1261; and District Lot 1261 except parts included within Plan 53 and shown on plan attached to D.D. 3457, all of Similkameen Division Yale District, the owner of the adjacent land.

THE LAND COMPRISED in the portion of road allowance hereinbefore mentioned be transferred to THE GRANBY MINING COMPANY LIMITED, without further or formal instrument of transfer, but upon compliance with the provisions of the "Land Registry Act" and the possible requirement that a subdivision plan be provided, subject to the conditions of the "Highway Act" and all other powers thereunto enabling, subject to the reservations, limitations, provisos, and conditions expressed in the original grant thereof from the Crown, and to the registered charges, if any, to which the said adjoining lands are subject, with the intent that the land hereby transferred be added to and form part of the said adjoining land, and that the Minister of Highways and Public Works be authorized to execute and deliver such further assurances of the above described lands as may in the premises be required.
