EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA 16 DEC 1976

Pursuant to the Highway Act, Section 11 (2) (a) ~~and~~, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

WHEREAS by notice dated October 14th., 1976 and published in The British Columbia Gazette of November 4th., 1976, the Minister of Highways and Public Works discontinued and closed all those portions of District Lots 194 and 195, Kootenay District, as shown outlined in green on a plan recorded in the Provincial Department of Highways and Public Works, Victoria, B.C., under Road Surveys 4906 (being a copy of Highway District Plan 9-137).

AND WHEREAS the Minister of Highways and Public Works deems it desirable to transfer to P N W INC., 1400 State Avenue, Marysville, Washington, U.S.A., the registered owner of FIRST: District Lot 194 Except parts included in Plans 9819 and 10023; SECONDLY: District Lots 195 Except part included in Plan 9819; and THIRDLY: Parcel "A" (Reference Plan 78150-I) of Parcel 1 (See 15671-I) and Parcel 2 (See 21540-I) of District Lot 193, Kootenay District, the owner of the adjacent land.

THE LAND COMPRISED in the portion of road allowance hereinbefore mentioned be transferred to P N W INC., without further or formal instrument of transfer, but upon compliance with the provisions of the "Land Registry Act" and the possible requirement that a subdivision plan be provided, subject to the conditions of the "Highway Act" and all other powers thereunto enabling, subject to the reservations, limitations, provisos, and conditions expressed in the original grant thereof from the Crown, and to the registered charges, if any, to which the said adjoining lands are subject, with the intent that the land hereby transferred be added to and form part of the said adjoining land, and that the Minister of Highways and Public Works be authorized to execute and deliver such further assurances of the above described lands as may in the premises be required.
