Division 25 of the Motor-Vehicle Act Regulations is amended as follows:

1. By amending Regulation 25.02 by adding after the words "Transport Act" in the seventh line the following:-

;and no person shall rent or lease or offer for rent or lease within an inspection area a motor-vehicle registered or licenced under the Act or the Commercial Transport Act

2. By adding to Regulation 25.04 the following as subsection (d):-

(d) The Superintendent may require the owner of a vehicle which has been damaged, modified, rebuilt, disposed of as salvage or remanufactured to present the vehicle for inspection prior to its operation on a highway to determine its safety of operation on a highway and that it conforms to the requirements of the Act and these regulations and such inspection shall

(i) where the owner resides within an inspection area the inspection shall be conducted at a vehicle inspection station or

(ii) where the owner does not reside within an inspection area the inspection may be conducted by an automotive mechanic who is the holder of a certificate of qualification as an automotive mechanic issued by the Department of Labour for the Province of British Columbia.
