SCHEDULE "B"

1. For the purpose of this Rate Schedule, the following definitions shall apply:

- (a) Bulk Consumers: All consumers outside the Municipality of Central Saanich, and the following Consumers within the Municipality of Central Saanich: The Brentwood Water District, the Tsawout Indian Band, and the Tsartlip Indian Band.
- (b) Fire Protection Purposes: All consumers having connections for fire protection purposes only.
- (c) Retail Consumers:
 - (i) Retail Consumer Residential Unit: shall mean each dwelling unit defined in Section 1.3 of Zoning By-Law No. 465 for Dwelling Apartment, Dwelling Detached, Dwelling Duplex, Dwelling Multiple, Dwelling semi-detached, and Dwelling Unit.
 - (ii) Retail Consumers Commercial, Industrial Unit: shall mean each unit as defined in Section 1.3 of Zoning By-Law No. 465 for Store Retail.

2. WATER RATES

- (a) Bulk Consumers: 35¢ per 1,000 Imperial gallons. Metered Bulk charges shall be billed monthly.
- (b) Retail Consumers: A Bi-monthly charge of \$12.00 including 10,000 Imperial Gallons of water each two month period not cumulative for each unit classified under Section 1 (c) (i) & (ii), and all other consumers not defined in Section 1 (a), (b) or (c). All metered water over 10,000 Imperial gallons each two month period shall be charged at 35¢ per 1,000 Imperial gallons. The minimum annual charge shall be \$62.00, exclusive of metered charges.
- (c) Fire Protection Purposes: An annual charge of \$24.00.
- (d) Connection charges: 5/8" x 3/4" connection - \$200.00. All applications for meters over 5/8" x 3/4" shall be subject to the approval of the Council, and will be installed at full cost.
- (e) Turning off charge: \$5.00
Turning on charge: \$5.00
- (f) Penalty for late payment: A 10% penalty shall be added to all retail charges of \$10.00 or more remaining unpaid on the 15th day of the month following the billing date.
- (g) Prepayment: A discount of \$3.00 shall be allowed retail consumers if a prepayment of the fixed charge for the full year is made during the month of January of the current year.
