

WHEREAS flooding and landslides pose a threat to lives, property and infrastructure in the Province of British Columbia;

AND WHEREAS prompt coordination of action and special regulation of persons or property is required to protect the health, safety or welfare of persons and to mitigate the impact of the flooding and landslides on the transportation network and the availability and distribution of essential goods and supplies throughout the Province of British Columbia;

NOW THEREFORE I declare that a state of emergency exists throughout the whole of the Province of British Columbia.
