



APPLIED BIOLOGISTS REGULATION

Definitions

- 1** (1) In this regulation:
- “**Act**” means the *Professional Governance Act*;
 - “**biological science**” includes botany, zoology, ecology, biochemistry and microbiology;
 - “**practice of applied biology**”, subject to subsection (2), means the provision of
 - (a) advice or services that
 - (i) are based on biological sciences, and
 - (ii) relate to aquatic or terrestrial ecosystems or the living organisms, habitats or processes of those ecosystems, or
 - (b) advice or services that are ancillary to those described in paragraph (a).
- (2) The practice of applied biology does not include the provision of advice or services within the reserved practice of a registrant of another regulatory body.

Regulated practice

- 2** For the purposes of the definition of “regulated practice” in section 4 [*definitions in respect of the College of Applied Biology*] of Schedule 1 of the Act, the practice of applied biology is prescribed.

Reserved title

- 3** For the purposes of section 51 (1) (a) [*reserved titles*] of the Act, the following titles are reserved for the exclusive use of registrants:
- (a) “professional biologist”;
 - (b) “biologist in training”;
 - (c) “registered biology technologist”;
 - (d) “registered biology technologist in training”;
 - (e) “applied biology technician”;
 - (f) “applied biology technician in training”.
