SCHEDULE

1 Section 14 (a) and (b) of the Business Practices and Consumer Protection Regulation, B.C. Reg. 294/2004, is repealed and the following substituted:

- (a) a payment that is directed to be made into the Consumer Advancement Fund in accordance with an undertaking under the following:
 - (i) section 154 [*undertakings*] of the Act;
 - (ii) section 56 (2) (b) [*application of Divisions 1 to 3 of Part 10 – inspections and enforcement*] of the *Cremation, Interment and Funeral Services Act*;
 - (iii) section 14 (2) (e) [*inspections and enforcement – undertakings*] of the *Ticket Sales Act*;
- (b) a payment that is directed to be made into the Consumer Advancement Fund in accordance with a compliance order under the following:
 - (i) section 155 [*compliance orders*] of the Act;
 - (ii) section 56 (2) (c) of the *Cremation, Interment and Funeral Services Act*;
 - (iii) section 14 (2) (f) [*inspections and enforcement – compliance orders*] of the *Ticket Sales Act*.

2 Section 15 is amended by adding the following paragraphs:

- (h) for the purpose of research related to consumer protection under the *Ticket Sales Act*;
- (i) for the purpose of paying grants to organizations for the delivery of services related to consumer protection under the *Ticket Sales Act*;
- (j) to pay the costs associated with planning or implementing programs related to consumer protection under the *Ticket Sales Act*;
- (k) to pay the costs associated with inspections or hearings that do not result in an undertaking, compliance order or administrative penalty under the *Ticket Sales Act*.
