

# ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT (PARTICIPATING INDIGENOUS NATIONS – ALASKA) ORDER

## Definitions

1 In this order:

“**Act**” means the *Environmental Assessment Act*;

“**participating Indigenous nation**” has the same meaning as in section 1 of the Act;

“**project**” has the same meaning as in section 1 of the Act;

“**specified Alaskan entity**” means any of the following:

- (a) Central Council of the Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes;
- (b) Chilkat Indian Village;
- (c) Craig Tribal Association;
- (d) Douglas Indian Association;
- (e) Hydaburg Cooperative Association;
- (f) Ketchikan Indian Community;
- (g) Klawock Cooperative Association;
- (h) Metlakatla Indian Community, Annette Island Reserve;
- (i) Organized Village of Kasaan;
- (j) Organized Village of Kake;
- (k) Organized Village of Saxman;
- (l) Petersburg Indian Association;
- (m) Sitka Tribe of Alaska;
- (n) Wrangell Cooperative Association;
- (o) Yakutat Tlingit Tribe;

“**specified official**” means any of the following within the meaning of the Act:

- (a) the minister;
- (b) a responsible minister;
- (c) the chief executive assessment officer;
- (d) a dispute resolution facilitator.

## Limitation on participation

2 (1) This order

- (a) applies despite the Act and whether or not notice has been provided under section 14 (1) or (2) of the Act, and
- (b) binds a specified official.

(2) In relation to the following projects, a specified Alaskan entity may not be a participating Indigenous nation and section 14 of the Act does not apply to a specified Alaskan entity:

- (a) Brucejack Gold Mine;
- (b) Eskay Creek Revitalization;

- (c) Galore Creek Copper-Gold-Silver;
- (d) Kerr-Sulphurets-Mitchell;
- (e) New Polaris Gold Mine;
- (f) Red Chris Porphyry Copper-Gold Mine.

**Expiry of order**

- 3** This order expires on September 15, 2027.
