

- 1** *The title of the Local Elections Campaign Financing Expense Limit Regulation, B.C. Reg. 309/2016, is repealed and the following substituted:*

LOCAL ELECTIONS CAMPAIGN FINANCING PRIOR TO 2022 GENERAL LOCAL ELECTION REGULATION .

- 2** *Section 2 is repealed and the following substituted:*

Application

- 2** This regulation does not apply in relation to the following:
- (a) assent voting or an election held before the 2018 general local election;
 - (b) the 2022 general local election;
 - (c) assent voting or an election held after the 2022 general local election.

- 3** *Section 62.4 is amended by adding the following subsection:*

- (0.1) This section applies for the purposes of establishing the campaign contribution limits for 2019, 2020 and 2021.

- 4** *Section 70 (2) is amended by repealing paragraphs (a) and (b) and substituting the following:*

- (a) the amount of space used to promote, directly or indirectly, the election of the candidate or oppose, directly or indirectly, the election of another candidate in the same election;
- (b) the amount of time used to promote, directly or indirectly, the election of the candidate or oppose, directly or indirectly, the election of another candidate in the same election.
