ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS AccessAbility Week is recognized nationally to promote inclusion and accessibility in communities and workplaces; to celebrate the contributions of Canadians with disabilities; and to recognize the individuals, communities and workplaces that actively remove barriers to give Canadians of all abilities a better chance to succeed, and

WHEREAS the Province of British Columbia is committed to upholding and safeguarding the principles outlined in the United Nations Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities, including full and effective participation and inclusion in society, and equality of opportunity, and

WHEREAS the Province joins all Canadians in recognizing that an inclusive Canada is one where all Canadians can participate and have an equal opportunity to succeed in their workplaces and communities, and

WHEREAS AccessAbility Week is an opportunity to celebrate accessibility in British Columbia and to recognize the importance of building a better British Columbia for people with disabilities by working towards becoming a fully accessible, inclusive province;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that May 31 to June 6, 2020, shall be known as

“AccessAbility Week”

in the Province of British Columbia.
