A Proclamation

ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS Autism Spectrum Disorder is a neurodevelopmental disorder that occurs in approximately one in every 66 children and youth, the causes of which are not fully understood, and

WHEREAS Autism Spectrum Disorder is four times more common in boys than girls, and has been found throughout the world in families of all ethnic and social backgrounds, and

WHEREAS Autism Spectrum Disorder affects a person's social relationships, communication, interests and behaviours, and

WHEREAS these differences may present in a wide variety of ways and to varying degrees of severity, and can cause the individual with an Autism Spectrum Disorder to have lifelong challenges relating to people, objects and events, and

WHEREAS early intervention for young children with Autism Spectrum Disorder may help them overcome behavioural challenges and develop communication, social and other skills, resulting in more meaningful participation in their communities, and

WHEREAS children, youth and adults with Autism Spectrum Disorder and their families can benefit from community supports and, with this assistance, an increasing number of individuals with Autism Spectrum Disorder are able to live and work independently, and

WHEREAS the British Columbia government wishes to raise the awareness of both practicing professionals and the public by providing information on Autism Spectrum Disorder and by encouraging research activities that will further our understanding of effective interventions across the lifespan for individuals who have Autism Spectrum Disorder;

NOW KNOW YE THAT, We do by these presents proclaim and declare that April 2018 shall be known as

“Autism Awareness Month”

and April 2, 2018 shall be known as


“World Autism Awareness Day”

in the Province of British Columbia.


