A Proclamation

ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS it is desirable to designate BC Agriculture Day to recognize the importance of the agriculture, seafood and food processing sectors to British Columbia's economy and communities, and

WHEREAS agriculture, seafood and food processing sector activities occur throughout the province, creating positive impact through job creation and access to safe, quality food products, and

WHEREAS the promotion of the agriculture, seafood and food processing sectors helps create public awareness of the practices, processes and products used in British Columbia to ensure the protection of public safety, climate change adaption, worker care and animal welfare, and

WHEREAS there is value in promoting Grow BC, Feed BC and Buy BC to support British Columbia businesses and encourage the public to eat locally grown, nutritious food products, and

WHEREAS it is important to increase our knowledge of the agriculture, seafood and food processing sectors to encourage youth and new entrants to pursue farming and related employment opportunities, and

WHEREAS the agriculture sector is leading the way in many technology advancements to address sustainability and food security, and

WHEREAS BC's fertile lands and rich oceans produce some of the world's highest quality food, and

WHEREAS agriculture in British Columbia has the advantage of proximity to markets and the drive to move ahead in a competitive world, and

WHEREAS increasing collaboration between the public, industry, academia and Indigenous groups will support the sustainable growth of the agriculture, seafood and food processing sectors, including in remote and rural communities in British Columbia;

NOW KNOW YE THAT, We do by these presents proclaim and declare that November 6, 2018 shall be known as


“BC Agriculture Day”

in the Province of British Columbia.
