ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS British Columbia's grasslands produce some of the world's highest quality cattle, and

WHEREAS British Columbia beef producers are renowned for the way in which their cattle are raised and processed in a healthy environment and ecologically sustainable manner, and

WHEREAS British Columbia cattle are part of an integrated Canadian beef production system that is well respected for having a high quality finished product, and

WHEREAS beef production in British Columbia has the advantage of proximity to markets and the drive to move ahead in a competitive world, and

WHEREAS the beef industry supports British Columbia's economy through almost \$219.2 million in farm cash receipts, and

WHEREAS the British Columbia beef industry is a vital component of the fabric of rural British Columbia, and

WHEREAS beef production and ranching often involves multi-generations working on the land to produce the highest quality product;

NOW KNOW YE THAT, We do by these presents proclaim and declare that May 16, 2018 shall be known as

“BC Beef Day”

in the Province of British Columbia.


