ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,  
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the  
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

**To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting**

WHEREAS BC's grasslands produce some of the world's highest-quality cattle, and

WHEREAS BC beef producers are renowned for the way in which their cattle are raised and processed in a healthy environment and ecologically sustainable manner, and

WHEREAS BC cattle are part of an integrated Canadian beef production system that is well respected for having a high-quality finished product, and

WHEREAS beef production in BC has the advantage of proximity to markets and the drive to move ahead in a competitive world, and

WHEREAS the beef industry supports BC's economy through \$235.9 million in farm cash receipts, and

WHEREAS the BC beef industry is a vital component of the fabric of rural BC, and

WHEREAS beef production and ranching often involve multi-generations working on the land to produce the highest-quality product;

NOW KNOW YE THAT, We do by these presents proclaim and declare that May 14, 2019 shall be known as

**“BC Beef Day”**

in the Province of British Columbia.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Our Province of British Columbia to be hereunto affixed.
