A Proclamation

ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS British Columbia's grasslands produce some of the world's highest quality cattle, and

WHEREAS British Columbia's beef producers are renowned for raising and processing their cattle in a healthy environment and in an ecologically sustainable manner, and

WHEREAS British Columbia's beef producers have demonstrated tremendous resiliency throughout the COVID-19 pandemic and through adverse climate events such as floods and wildfires, and

WHEREAS as part of an integrated Canadian beef production system that is known for its high-quality finished product, British Columbia's beef industry has the advantage of proximity to markets and the drive to move ahead in a competitive world, supporting British Columbia's food economy through the hard work of more than 5 500 people in the sector, and

WHEREAS beef production and ranching often involves multiple generations working on the land to produce high-quality product that contributes to British Columbia's food security, and the beef industry is a vital component of the fabric of rural British Columbia;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that June 2, 2022, shall be known as

“BC Beef Day”

in the Province of British Columbia.
