ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS for 30 years, the BC Blueberry Council has worked closely with growers, packers and processors to unify the province's growers and consumers, making British Columbia's blueberry industry a leader in quality, nutrition and food safety, and

WHEREAS British Columbia is one of the top 10 blueberry regions in the world, and British Columbia's blueberries are Canada's top small fruit export, and

WHEREAS each blueberry grown in British Columbia provides natural energy and superfood health benefits to people around the world, and

WHEREAS BC Blueberry Day is an opportunity to celebrate the local industry that produces delicious and nutritious blueberries grown and harvested in British Columbia;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that July 15, 2021, shall be known as

“BC Blueberry Day”

in the Province of British Columbia.
