ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS the Province of British Columbia celebrates the importance of museums, art galleries, historic sites, cultural centres and other memory institutions as keepers of legacy, places of learning, and drivers for the economic and social well-being of British Columbia's communities, and

WHEREAS museums, cultural centres and heritage organizations are uniquely positioned to play a role in reconciliation initiatives, including those related to protecting and promoting Indigenous languages and cultures, and

WHEREAS museums play a valued role in British Columbia's communities, connecting people to collections, knowledge, ideas and each other, and

WHEREAS these institutions have the power to initiate dialogue between cultures and to encourage greater respect and understanding of one another;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that May 17 to 23, 2021, shall be known as


“BC Museums Week”

in the Province of British Columbia.


