ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS wild salmon are a fundamental component of the cultural, historical and economic way of life for First Nations and British Columbians, and

WHEREAS wild salmon are a keystone species, a part of intricate food webs in both their fresh water and marine environments, and

WHEREAS British Columbia's wild salmon stocks are vulnerable and deserve our support, and

WHEREAS the protection and restoration of the habitats of British Columbia's wild salmon are vital to the sustainability of their species, and

WHEREAS British Columbia is committed to working collaboratively to help restore this keystone species;

NOW KNOW YE THAT, We do by these presents proclaim and declare that May 16, 2019 shall be known as


“B.C. Wild Salmon Day”

in the Province of British Columbia.
