ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,  
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the  
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

**To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting**

WHEREAS wild salmon are a fundamental component of the cultural, historical and economic way of life for Indigenous peoples and British Columbians, and

WHEREAS wild salmon are a keystone species, a critical part of intricate food webs in both their freshwater and marine environments, and

WHEREAS British Columbia's wild salmon are vulnerable and deserve support, and

WHEREAS protection and restoration of British Columbia's wild salmon habitats are vital to the recovery of the species, and

WHEREAS the government of British Columbia is committed to working collaboratively to help restore this keystone species;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that June 1, 2021, shall be known as

**“BC Wild Salmon Day”**

in the Province of British Columbia.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Our Province of British Columbia to be hereunto affixed.
