ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS British Columbians take pride in and enjoy the high-quality products produced in communities throughout this province, and

WHEREAS British Columbia's wine industry includes many family-run vineyards and wineries, with farmers, grape growers, viticulturists and winemakers who have chosen farming and winemaking as their passion and profession and who deserve to be supported, and

WHEREAS British Columbia's wine industry provides stable, value-added farming and manufacturing jobs to more than 12 000 people in communities throughout the province, with an annual economic impact of \$2.8 billion, and

WHEREAS British Columbia is home to 929 vineyards, including more than 370 licensed wineries that welcome over 1 million visitors each year, and

WHEREAS approximately 4 250 hectares of wine grapes are grown in British Columbia, with more than 80 grape varieties produced in the province;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that April 2021 shall be known as


“BC Wine Month”

in the Province of British Columbia.


