ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS Bullying Awareness Day (Pink Shirt Day) highlights British Columbia's commitment to a safe and inclusive province, and

WHEREAS acts of bullying, cyberbullying, harassment, intimidation and violence have a profound effect on an individual's feelings of safety, self-worth and ability to learn, and

WHEREAS acts of bullying, cyberbullying, harassment, intimidation and violence are unacceptable in a safe, caring and orderly society, and

WHEREAS communities, workplaces, families, schools and individuals all have critical roles to play in modelling, teaching and promoting socially responsible behaviour, and

WHEREAS Bullying Awareness Day (Pink Shirt Day) recognizes efforts to build communities fostering respect, inclusion, fairness, equity and compassion, and

WHEREAS Bullying Awareness Day (Pink Shirt Day) is an opportunity to actively promote respectful and kind behaviour, and

WHEREAS Bullying Awareness Day (Pink Shirt Day) is an occasion to celebrate the actions of individuals, schools and communities to address bullying, cyberbullying, harassment, intimidation and violence;

NOW KNOW YE THAT, We do by these presents proclaim and declare that February 28, 2018 shall be known as

“Bullying Awareness Day (Pink Shirt Day)”

in the Province of British Columbia.
