ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS complex regional pain syndrome (CRPS), also known as reflex sympathetic dystrophy (RSD), is a condition that causes chronic pain, and

WHEREAS CRPS/RSD is not well understood and can be difficult to diagnose, and

WHEREAS CRPS/RSD Awareness Day is an opportunity to raise awareness of this potentially debilitating condition and to show support for people who are affected by this condition;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that November 1, 2021, shall be known as

“CRPS/RSD Awareness Day”

in the Province of British Columbia.
