ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS a champion and voice for Canadians affected by cancer, the Canadian Cancer Society funds cancer research, provides services to those living with cancer, and educates and advocates on important cancer-related issues, and

WHEREAS Canadian Cancer Society volunteers and local donors in British Columbia are part of a collective of people helping to improve the lives and experiences of those affected by cancer, and

WHEREAS the daffodil is a symbol of strength, courage and life for those living with cancer and a symbol for communities to rally around when showing support, donating or volunteering, and

WHEREAS the Canadian Cancer Society's Daffodil Campaign raises funds to invest in research and support systems that make life better for people affected by cancer;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that April 2021 shall be known as

“Canadian Cancer Society's Daffodil Month”

in the Province of British Columbia.
