ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS Canadian Agriculture Literacy Month (CALM) is a collaborative effort by Agriculture in the Classroom Canada and its provincial member associations, including the BC Agriculture in the Classroom Foundation (BCAIFC), to highlight the importance of agriculture literacy nationwide each March, and

WHEREAS for the past 10 years, CALM has been celebrated annually across British Columbia, encouraging thousands of K-12 students to celebrate British Columbia's unique agriculture and food story, and

WHEREAS CALM connects students with hands-on, interactive agriculture learning opportunities throughout March, and

WHEREAS agriculture literacy programs, resources and initiatives ensure that youth have solid foundations in agriculture literacy for life-long understanding of food from farm to table, and

WHEREAS providing education about the significance that the agriculture and food sector has in the daily lives of British Columbians is essential to maintaining food security, the economy and the health of this province;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that March 2022 shall be known as

“Canadian Agriculture Literacy Month”

in the Province of British Columbia.
