A Proclamation

ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS the government of British Columbia is committed to ensuring the safety and security of all those living in and visiting British Columbia, and

WHEREAS illness and death from carbon monoxide poisoning is preventable, and

WHEREAS the government of British Columbia, British Columbia's fire service and other life and safety organizations are dedicated to reducing the occurrence of carbon monoxide poisoning through prevention and protection education, and

WHEREAS British Columbians are responsive to public education measures, can take personal steps to increase their safety from carbon monoxide poisoning, and can, by working together with the government of British Columbia and the British Columbia fire service, lead the way in making British Columbia safer and reduce the number of people who become ill or die from carbon monoxide poisoning, and

WHEREAS people who properly install, test and replace carbon monoxide alarms and who properly maintain and correctly use fuel-burning appliances are better protected from the build-up of carbon monoxide and will be more readily able to respond appropriately to the presence of carbon monoxide;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that November 1 to 7, 2021, shall be known as

“Carbon Monoxide Awareness Week”

in the Province of British Columbia.
