A Proclamation

ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS Universal Children's Day 2021 commemorates the 1989 adoption of the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child and the 1959 adoption of the United Nations Declaration of the Rights of the Child, and

WHEREAS the government of British Columbia endorses and upholds the rights of children, as established in the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child, and

WHEREAS the government of British Columbia continues building on its commitment to children's rights; has a vision for British Columbia's children and youth to be healthy, safe and supported to reach their full potential; and recognizes that government, communities and families share a role in supporting children and youth to live healthy lives, and

WHEREAS Indigenous children and youth thrive best within their own cultures and traditions, and the government of British Columbia continues working with Indigenous leaders, and with communities, to more fully implement the Convention's principles for all Indigenous children in British Columbia, and

WHEREAS Child and Youth Day is an opportunity to celebrate that children and youth represent the promise of British Columbia's future and to recognize the importance of honouring child and youth rights on November 20 and throughout the year;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that November 20, 2021, shall be known as

“Child and Youth Day”

in the Province of British Columbia.
