A Proclamation

ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS a cancer diagnosis at any age can be devastating, and a sense of pervasive isolation can make things even harder for children with cancer and their families, and

WHEREAS children who survive an initial cancer may develop lifetime side effects or another form of malignant cancer, or both, and

WHEREAS it is important to support the mental and emotional health of children and youth with cancer, and that of their families, and

WHEREAS organizations like the Childhood Cancer Family Support Society and the Island Kids Cancer Association help connect families in British Columbia who have children with cancer to support networks, counselling, education, therapy, financial assistance and community programs, and

WHEREAS Childhood Cancer Awareness Month is an opportunity to raise awareness of childhood cancer and to show support for families who have children with cancer;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that September 2022 shall be known as

“Childhood Cancer Awareness Month”

in the Province of British Columbia.
