ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS Children's Grief Awareness Day is an opportunity to let grieving children know that they are not forgotten in the midst of their grief;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that November 21, 2019, shall be known as

“Children's Grief Awareness Day”

in the Province of British Columbia.


