To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS the trainers initiate innovative career development strategies that provide their clients with relevant work skills that enable them to contribute to the present and future work force, and

WHEREAS these individuals are taught necessary life skills and are encouraged and empowered to continually seek ways to achieve their long-term quality of life, and

WHEREAS the training is rooted in the community, and the community-based trainers support and encourage their clients to access community services that support them in achieving meaningful and sustainable livelihoods;

NOW KNOW YE THAT, We do by these presents proclaim and declare that March 18 to 24, 2018 shall be known as


“Community-based Trainers Week”

in the Province of British Columbia.


