A Proclamation

ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS Cops for Cancer engages communities, law enforcement and emergency services personnel to cycle across the province in support of pediatric cancer research and Canadian Cancer Society support services, and

WHEREAS hundreds of first responders have raised over \$47 million over 22 years to support children and families impacted by cancer, and

WHEREAS their efforts have helped the five-year survival rate of childhood cancers improve to more than 80% and support 600 BC children and their families in attending Camp Goodtimes, a medically supervised summer recreation experience, and

WHEREAS, on September 22, all four BC Cops for Cancer tours will be riding, and the Vancouver and Fraser Valley regions will be celebrating 20 years of cycling to end childhood cancer;

NOW KNOW YE THAT, We do by these presents proclaim and declare that September 22, 2019 shall be known as

“Cops for Cancer Day”

in the Province of British Columbia.
