ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,  
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the  
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

**To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting**

WHEREAS the diverse cultural heritage of British Columbians contributes greatly to life in our province, and

WHEREAS the Government of British Columbia is committed to the ideal of a harmonious society based on mutual respect and where diversity is respected and valued, and

WHEREAS the Government of British Columbia wishes to join with community groups across the province in recognizing the diverse and multicultural nature of our society, and

WHEREAS the United Nations General Assembly has proclaimed May 21 as World Day for Cultural Diversity;

NOW KNOW YE THAT, We do by these presents proclaim and declare that May 19 to 25, 2019 shall be known as

**“Cycling4Diversity Week”**

in the Province of British Columbia.
