ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS the diverse cultural heritage of British Columbians contributes greatly to life in this province, and

WHEREAS the government of British Columbia is committed to the ideal of a harmonious society based on mutual respect, where diversity is respected and valued, and

WHEREAS the government of British Columbia wishes to join with communities across the province in recognizing the diverse and multicultural nature of this society, and

WHEREAS in December 2002, the United Nations General Assembly declared May 21 as World Day for Cultural Diversity for Dialogue and Development, and

WHEREAS this year, people across the province will be riding virtually to raise awareness of diversity and anti-racism issues and to celebrate the 10th anniversary of Cycling4Diversity Week in socially distanced ways;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that May 16 to 22, 2021, shall be known as

“Cycling4Diversity Week”

in the Province of British Columbia.
