ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,

**To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting**

WHEREAS cystic fibrosis is one of the most common genetic diseases affecting children and young adults in Canada, and

WHEREAS Cystic Fibrosis Canada, a charitable organization committed to finding a cure for cystic fibrosis, continues to champion cystic fibrosis research, innovation and patient care, and

WHEREAS due to significant progress in cystic fibrosis research and treatment, the life expectancy for people with cystic fibrosis has improved, and many children with cystic fibrosis in Canada will reach adulthood, and

WHEREAS Cystic Fibrosis Canada is committed to ensuring that those living with cystic fibrosis have access to the innovative treatments and medications they need to live healthier and longer lives, and

WHEREAS Cystic Fibrosis Awareness Month is an opportunity to show support for those living with this disease and for the goal of finding a cure for cystic fibrosis;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that May 2022 shall be known as

**“Cystic Fibrosis Awareness Month”**
