ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS the honeybee and other bee pollinators have been an important part of our agricultural efforts since ancient times, and

WHEREAS the honeybee and other bee pollinators play an essential role in the success of agricultural enterprises in British Columbia, and

WHEREAS the honeybee and other bee pollinators have been under serious threat due to diseases and environmental conditions that ultimately threaten the future of agriculture in our province, and

WHEREAS the Government of British Columbia has worked with the agricultural industry to improve production and stabilize the industry, and

WHEREAS it is in the interests of furthering that goal to raise awareness of the role of the honeybee and other bee pollinators and the plight they face;

NOW KNOW YE THAT, We do by these presents proclaim and declare that May 29, 2018 shall be known as


“Day of the Honeybee”
