WHEREAS the Province is committed to upholding and safeguarding the principles outlined in the United Nations Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities, including full and effective participation and inclusion in society, and equality of opportunity, and

WHEREAS the Province is committed to working with employers to recruit, retain and promote people with disabilities in their workplaces to stimulate economic growth and increase productivity, and

WHEREAS the significant contributions of people with disabilities and employers who demonstrate inclusion and leadership are acknowledged, shared and celebrated;

NOW KNOW YE THAT, We do by these presents proclaim and declare that September 2019 shall be known as




in the Province of British Columbia.
