A Proclamation

CHARLES THE THIRD, by the Grace of God, King of Canada
and His other Realms and Territories, Head of the Commonwealth

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS the government of British Columbia recognizes that meaningful employment is significant to people with disabilities who can and want to work, and

WHEREAS the government of British Columbia is committed to upholding and safeguarding the principles outlined in the United Nations Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities, including full and effective participation and inclusion in society and equality of opportunity, and

WHEREAS the government of British Columbia is committed to working with employers to recruit, retain and promote people with disabilities in their workplaces to stimulate economic growth and increase productivity across British Columbia, and

WHEREAS the significant contributions of people with disabilities and employers who demonstrate inclusion and leadership are acknowledged, shared and celebrated;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that September 2023 shall be known as

“Disability Employment Month”

in the Province of British Columbia.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Our Province of British Columbia to be hereunto affixed.
