ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS eating disorders result in high mortality rates and can develop in anyone, regardless of age, ethno-racial background, socio-economic status, gender or ability, and

WHEREAS Eating Disorders Awareness Week seeks to raise awareness of eating disorders, shed light on dangerous and pervasive myths, and promote prevention, and

WHEREAS the provincial Eating Disorders Awareness Week (PEDAW) campaign launches annually in February with events and activities taking place throughout the year, and

WHEREAS PEDAW is a province-wide effort to raise awareness around prevention of and early intervention for eating disorders and to promote media literacy, resiliency and the building of healthy body images and self-esteem, and

WHEREAS PEDAW is led by Jessie's Legacy Eating Disorders Prevention and Awareness program at Family Services of the North Shore in collaboration with the Kelty Mental Health Resource Centre, the Looking Glass Foundation for Eating Disorders, the Provincial Tertiary Eating Disorders Program at St. Paul's Hospital and the BC Children's Hospital Eating Disorders Program;

in the Province of British Columbia.


