A Proclamation

ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS the United Nations established October 11 as the annual International Day of the Girl Child, supported by Canada and 97 other countries, and

WHEREAS quality and universal access to education for every girl and boy are among the United Nations' Millennium Development Goals, supported by 189 countries, including Canada, and

WHEREAS the "Day of the Girl" campaign calls on communities across the globe to recognize that girls worldwide face many injustices, such as gendercide, discrimination, gender stereotypes, child marriage and lack of education, and empowers girls to fight for their rights, and

WHEREAS organizations, such as the GirlKIND Foundation, support providing equal opportunities for all girls by speaking out against gender-based injustices, valuing all girls' lives, celebrating all girls' potential and encouraging all girls to pursue their potential and dreams;

NOW KNOW YE THAT, We do by these presents proclaim and declare that the day of October 11, 2018 shall be known as


"Every Girl Matters Day"

in the Province of British Columbia.
