WHEREAS family physicians are highly skilled generalists and bring a unique orientation and skill set, strengthening the compassion, comprehensiveness, cohesion, capacity and overall quality of the health care system, and

WHEREAS collectively, the care provided by family physicians improves the overall health of the population, and

WHEREAS we celebrate this day together with family physicians across the world to recognize the progress being made in family medicine and the special contributions of family doctors in British Columbia and globally;

NOW KNOW YE THAT, We do by these presents proclaim and declare that May 19, 2018 shall be known as

**“Family Doctor Day”**


