ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS improving the reading, writing and other essential skills of all British Columbians is vital to the social and economic development of the province, and

WHEREAS literacy in all its forms directly impacts British Columbians' ability to improve their quality of life, earn sufficient income, participate in learning, and fully engage with their communities, and

WHEREAS families have a strong influence on the literacy development of their children, and

WHEREAS family literacy programs promote a solid foundation for literacy and life-long learning, and provide an opportunity for children and families to learn together;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that January 23 to 30, 2022, shall be known as

“Family Literacy Week”

in the Province of British Columbia.
