**To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting**

WHEREAS Financial Literacy Day highlights the importance of financial education in British Columbia, and

WHEREAS it is in the best interests of young people to acquire knowledge and skills in financial literacy in order to contribute to the world, to make decisions as an educated citizen, and to further their education and future career prospects, and

WHEREAS financial literacy and financial education are significant for student learning and are prioritized in K-12 British Columbia curriculum, within Mathematics, Applied Design, Skills and Technology, and Career Education, and

WHEREAS Financial Literacy Day is an opportunity to emphasize the importance of financial literacy, and

WHEREAS Financial Literacy Day recognizes efforts to advocate for financial education, and

WHEREAS Financial Literacy Day is an occasion to support financial literacy projects and programs, and

WHEREAS students across the province are encouraged to take part in age-appropriate conversations about financial education on Financial Literacy Day;

NOW KNOW YE THAT, We do by these presents proclaim and declare that April 17, 2019 shall be known as
