ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,  
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the  
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

**To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting**

WHEREAS it is in the best interests of young people to acquire knowledge and skills in financial literacy in order to contribute to the world, to make decisions as educated citizens, and to further their education and future career prospects, and

WHEREAS financial literacy and financial education are significant for student learning and are prioritized in K-12 British Columbia curriculum, within Mathematics, Applied Design, Skills and Technology, and Career Education, and

WHEREAS students across the province are encouraged to take part in age-appropriate conversations about financial education on Financial Literacy Day, and

WHEREAS Financial Literacy Day is an opportunity to emphasize the importance of financial literacy, to recognize advocacy efforts for financial education, and to support financial literacy projects and programs;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that April 21, 2021, shall be known as


**“Financial Literacy Day”**


