ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS Food Day Canada is Canada's largest and longest-running celebration of farmers, fishers, food processors, chefs, researchers and home cooks, taking time to enjoy Canadian, homegrown food and drinks while shining a light on Canadian cuisine, and

WHEREAS Food Day Canada is a time to enjoy and celebrate locally grown food and the food that unites peoples and communities in Canada from coast to coast and to visit markets and restaurants and cook favourite recipes that feature British Columbian and Canadian ingredients, and

WHEREAS Food Day Canada is a time for all peoples and communities in British Columbia and Canada to share their food stories and celebrate food together, in person or online, while showing appreciation for all the great people in Canada's food system from farms to tables in British Columbia;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that July 31, 2021, shall be known as

“Food Day BC”

in the Province of British Columbia.
